

INTERNATIONAL AWARD-WINNING PHOTOGRAPHER SHARES HER EXPERTISE WITH CIVIC CLUB MEMBERS

RICHMOND HILL, GA - December 7, 2016 – During the Rotary Club of Richmond Hill's Dec. 1 meeting, local international award-winning photographer Megan Myrick provided members with tips and tricks for taking better photos of children.

The civic club, which meets weekly at the City Center in J.F. Gregory Park, welcomed the local business woman, who owns and operates Megan Myrick Photography, based in Richmond Hill. Attendees picked up plenty of pointers for creatively capturing the likeness of pint-sized moving targets – especially handy knowledge to have as the holidays approach – and posed various questions.

Myrick and her assistant, Lauren Gable, specialize in newborn, maternity, baby, child and family photography around the Coastal Georgia area. Myrick strives to provides her clients with a custom portrait experience resulting in timeless, heirloom-quality art for families to cherish for years to come.

A native of Washington state, Myrick and her family moved to Richmond Hill over three years ago due to her husband's military service. He has since retired from the Army, but the family chose to make Richmond Hill their permanent home. Since laying down roots in Coastal Georgia, Myrick has made it a priority to give back to her community, and she regularly teams up with local charities to raise donations for people in need. Myrick recently partnered with United Way and Family Promise of Bryan County, donating partial proceeds from her Halloween and holiday themed sessions to help the two nonprofits.

"Being heavily involved is extremely important to me and I always find happiness while doing it," Myrick said. "Whether it's presenting at local clubs and organizations, giving back to area residents in need, or sharing my photography knowledge with others during my Tiny Clicks classes, immersing myself in the community is so rewarding."

For those who are interested in Myrick's photography tips but did not have the opportunity to attend her Rotary presentation, Tiny Clicks is a workshop offered by Myrick that teaches parents and young adults how to rely less on their cameras' "auto" and "semi-auto" modes so they can begin to master exposure settings and shoot in manual mode. Participants receive a presentation manual that includes diagrams and examples for what they will learn as well as access to the private Facebook group where the learning and sharing continues. This class is limited to only five participants and is only offered four times a year so be sure to book a spot when registration is open.
